# InstantAtlas™ 6.5.2 Templates Release Notes

## 1. Overview

The version 6.5.2 templates have been released to address a small number of bugs. The HTML Profile Template is not affected by these bugs and does not therefore require a new version. No other parts of the InstantAtlas Desktop software have changed.

We recommend that you upgrade to the v6.5.2 templates since some of the bugs we have addressed affect most users of InstantAtlas (see below).

## 2. Bug Fixes

- The initial zoom level of the map will now show the map in full extent (previously it was slightly zoomed in).
- The Bubble Plot component no longer disappears from the Design View in the Designer.
- The issue with truncation of the title text (or texts containing substitution variables) is now fixed.
- The Advanced Pie Chart with the 'Data Source=associate' now automatically picks up all associates of the selected indicator. Administrators can define a 'List Of Associates To Ignore' in case there are associates which do not belong to the logical total of the Pie Chart. This fixes the issue whereby all associate names of all indicators would appear in the Advanced Pie Chart legend.
- Opening a report on a specific indicator using the URL parameter 'indicator=xxx' now opens the latest time period of this indicator when the 'date=xxx' parameter is not defined in the URL.

## 3. Versioning

All templates with exception of the HTML Profile Template will show as version 6.5.2 in the Publisher 'Choose a template' drop down list. The software installer number has been increased to 6.5.2 as shown if you check the software information through the Windows Control Panel. The Desktop Tools (Publisher, Designer and Style Editor) remain at version 6.5.0 since the source code of these tools has not changed.

## 4. Upgrading to 6.5.2 Templates

### 4.1. How to upgrade (applies to customers only)



1. Login to **My InstantAtlas** by browsing to <http://www.instantatlas.com/mialogin.aspx>
2. If you have not already registered for an account you should click the New User option.
3. Download the installer file (.exe) from the Desktop Maintenance area to the computer(s) with your current InstantAtlas installation(s).
4. Double-click the file to run the installer. Choose a language for the installation. The standard installation is recommended for most users. The advanced installation essentially allows you to install additional language features (French, German and Spanish).



1. Navigieren Sie zu <http://www.instantatlas.com/de/mialogin.aspx> um sich bei **Mein InstantAtlas** einzuloggen.
2. Falls Sie sich noch nicht registriert haben, sollten Sie auf den Link „New User“ klicken.
3. Laden Sie die Installationsdatei (.exe) herunter und speichern Sie diese auf dem Computer auf dem derzeit InstantAtlas installiert ist.
4. Starten Sie die Datei mit einem Doppelklick. Wählen Sie eine Sprache für die Installation aus. Für die meisten Benutzer wird empfohlen, die Standardinstallation durchzuführen. Die erweiterte Installation ermöglicht Ihnen hauptsächlich, weitere Sprachmodule (Französisch und Spanisch) zu installieren.



1. Navegue a <http://www.instantatlas.com/mialogin.aspx> para entrar en su cuenta **My InstantAtlas**
2. Si no tiene una cuenta Mi InstantAtlas, haga clic en la opción New User.
3. Descargue el fichero de instalación (.exe) en el ordenador(es) con su instalación(es) actual de InstantAtlas.
4. Haga clic-doble en el fichero de instalación. La instalación estándar conviene a la mayoría de los usuarios. La instalación

avanzada sobre todo permite la instalación de otras idiomas (francés o alemán).

## 4.2. Compatibility Notes

You may wish to publish a v6.5.2 dynamic report to benefit from the bug fixes but retain the data and custom design that you created for an older report. Of the files that contain the data/design, some can be safely copied over from an older report while others cannot. The table below shows the versions of reports it is safe to copy files across from.

File	v6.x report until v6.4.1	v6.5.0 report
Data files (data.xml and supporting theme XML files)	Yes, can be copied to a v6.5.2 report	Yes, can be copied to a v6.5.2 report
Stylesheet (default.css)	Can only be copied to a v6.5.2 report if the report does not contain contextual layers. Note that the old style sheet will not contain styles for any components that were new in v6.5.0.	Yes, can be copied to a v6.5.2 report.
Configuration file (config.xml)	No, should not be copied to a v6.5.2 report. Please use the Configuration File Converter within My InstantAtlas to update your old config file.	Yes, can be copied to a v6.5.2 report, unless you are using the Advanced Pie Chart. Please use the Configuration File Converter within My InstantAtlas to update your old config file.
